

THE CRESCENT SHAWL

The Crescent Shawl is designed for beginner. It consists of mindless garter stitch throughout the body, which is perfect for beginners to practice their basic knitting skills. Simple increase and easy Short Rows technique are also added to create little shaping to this colorful shawl.

The sample is knitted using one cake of Scheepjes Whirl yarn, but you can easily use 3 different colors of fingering weight yarn to achieve the same effect. The instruction for color change when using fingering weight yarn is included in the pattern.

Materials

Yarn

Scheepjes Whirl (69% Cotton, 40% Acrylic 215-225 grams, 1000 meters) Sample is knitted in colorway Fruity O' Tutti and Tasty Nom Nom.

Or

Fingering weight yarns, 3 colors (Approx. 366 m/100g)

The sample uses Kettu Yarn in the following colorway Section 1 : Color A – Aquamarine Section 2 : Color B – On the Sunny Side Section 3 : Color C – Summer Moments Section 4 : Color B – On the Sunny Side


Needles

3,5mm (80-100 cm) circular needles

Abbreviations

CO	cast on	WS	wrong side
Κ	knit	st(s)	stitch(es)
KFB	knit front and back	W&T	wrap and turn
RS	right side	K2tog tbl	knit 2 tog through the back loop

Instructions Section 1: Crescent Shape Using long-tail cast-on, CO 7 sts

Row 1 (RS) K2, KFB, KFB, K3; 9 sts Row 2 (WS) K2, KFB, K2, KFB, K3; 11 sts Row 3 (RS) K2, KFB, KFB, knit to last 5 sts, KFB. KFB, K3; 15 sts Row 4 (WS) K2, KFB, knit to last 4 sts, KFB, K3; 17 sts

Repeat rows 3 & 4, 50 more times; 317 sts

Fingering version :

Cast on with color A and continue throughout the whole Section 1 with Color A

Section 2: Short rows on the Right Side

Row 5 (RS) K2, KFB, KFB, K10, W&T; 319 sts

- Row 6 (WS) Knit to last 4 sts, KFB, K3; 320 sts
- **Row 7 (RS)** K2, KFB, KFB, knit to last wrapped stitch, knit the wrapped stitch, K10, W&T; 322 sts

Row 8 (WS) Knit to last 4 sts, KFB, K3; 323 sts

Repeat rows 7 & 8, 26 more times; 401 sts

Fingering version :

Change to Color B at the beginning of Section 2 and continue with Color B for the whole Section 2

Transition

Row 9 (RS) K2, KFB, KFB, knit to last 5 sts, KFB KFB, K3; 405 sts

Fingering version :

Change to Color C at the beginning of Transition Row 9 and continue with Color C for the whole Section 3 below

Section 3: Short Rows on the Wrong Side

- Row 10 (WS)
 K2, KFB, K10, W&T; 406 sts

 Row 11 (RS)
 Knit to last 5 sts, KFB, KFB, K3; 408 sts

 Row 12 (WS)
 K2, KFB, knit to last wrapped stitch, knit the wrapped stitch, knit the wrapped stitch, knit the wrapped stitch, K10, W&T; 409 sts
- Rows 13 (RS) Knit to last 5 sts, KFB, KFB, K3; 411 sts

Repeat rows 12 & 13, 34 more times; 513 sts



Section 4: Crescent Shape

Row 14 (WS)

K2, KFB, knit to last 4 sts (Note: Do NOT pick up the wrap!), KFB, K3; 515 sts

Row 15 (RS)

K2, KFB, KFB, knit to last 5 sts, KFB, KFB, K3; 519 sts

Row 16 (WS)

K2, KFB, knit to last 4 sts, KFB, K3; 521 sts

Repeat rows 15 & 16, 2 more times; 533 sts

Fingering version :

Change to Color B at the beginning of Section 4 Row 14 and Bind-off after Row 16

Elastic Bind Off

K1, *K1, insert the left hand needle into the 2 sts on the right needle (on top of the right needle), K2tog tbl (1 st left on the right needle). Repeat from * until you have bound off all sts.

Weave in ends.





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
